

Visit the charming fishing village of Bugøynes from Kirkenes! Bugøynes (Pykeijä) is a small fishing village located 100km from Kirkenes by the gleaming shores of Varangerfjord. The charming village has a fascinating history since it was established by Finnish settlers in the 1800s. This is the reason why the village is also called Little Finland (Pikku-Suomi), or by its Finnish name Pykeijä. Bugøynes is also one of the few villages in northern Norway which was not burnt down during World War II.

The village is known for its king crab industry, Finnish sauna culture and picturesque surrounding. The daytrip offers the best bits of the Finnish-Norwegian village including a thrilling experience of arctic bathing straight from the sauna, and a king crab safari including a taste of the famous king crabs. During the day you will also learn many interesting facts of the area!

On Fridays all year round (or according to availability on other days)
The tour is weather dependent. In bad weather the king crab safari can be replaced with a 3-course dinner with King Crab as main course in Restaurant Bistroen







#### **Bugøynes**

Bugøynes is a beautiful fishing village situated approx. 100 km west of Kirkenes. As the village was not burnt by the Germans during World War II, many old buildings are preserved. Bugøynes has strong cultural influences from the many Finns who migrated here in the late 19<sup>th</sup> century, and is often referred to as "Little Finland".

Bugøynes is a centre in Norway for the commercial fishery of king crabs, which are exported live around the world.

Neiden, which lies along the Neiden River, consists of two villages: Neiden on the Norwegian side and Näätämö on the Finnish side.

#### **Pasvik**

Pasvik Valley is a beautiful region located near the borders of Norway, Russia, and Finland. It spans over 100 km and is home to dense forests of pine and birch, as well as protected areas of ancient forests and wetlands. The valley is known for its diverse flora and fauna, where eastern and western species meet. The region is home to Norway's highest population of brown bears and over 220 bird species. The Pasvik River flows through the valley, forming the border between Norway and Russia, and continues south to Lake Inari in Finland through the Øvre Pasvik National Park.




